- SHOOTING HOURS 10:00 AM TO ½ HOUR BEFORE DUSK EVERY DAY, ESPECIALLY SUNDAY
- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
- NO GLASS TARGETS
- NAIL TARGETS BETWEEN BACKSTOP POSTS
- DO NOT SHOOT THE BACKSTOP POSTS
- ALL GUN ACTIONS MUST BE OPEN WHEN NOT IN SHOOTING POSITION
- LOADED GUNS ONLY ON THE FIRING RANGE
- NO CHILDREN UNATTENDED
- CLEAN UP AFTER SHOOTING ESPECIALLY TARGET AREA
- PLACE WASTE IN TRASH CONTAINERS
- NO VEHICLES BEYOND SHOOTING BENCHES
- NO RANDOM SHOOTING
- NO FULLY AUTOMATIC WEAPONS PERMITTED
- IT IS SUGGESTED TO USE THE 3 SECOND RULE BETWEEN SHOTS WITH CENTER-FIRED SEMI-

AUTOMATIC RIFLES ESPECIALLY FOR NEW SHOOTERS USING THESE WEAPONS

GUEST AND COMBINATION LOCK POLICY

- Paid up members in good standing may invite up to a total of three guests during a calendar year January thru December.

REQUESTED PRACTICES

SECURING THE GATE WHEN ENTERING AND LEAVING CLUB GROUNDS

- When you drive in, stop and lock the gate behind you to keep non-members off the property.
- When you leave, lock the gate, even if there are other members still on the property.
