- I. Memberships:

- IV. Old Business:
 - a. Doors still need painted. Scott would like to keep them white. He will look for paint.
 - b. Approximately 20 scouts will be using the club on Monday, August 15, 2022
 - c. Archery range discussion included: Is it being used? Could it be turned into a 22 Rim Fire range?

 - e. Chuck Myer to remove the pine wood.
- V. New Business:
 - a. Cliff Hammer inquired as to when the club would like him to mow the high grass areas again. He mentioned that it is costly.
 - b. Ken Hitz called CAC associates for the cost of trap targets.
 - i. 1 box is 14.80 + tax for a total of \$15.69
 - ii. Based on the cost of one skid of targets, the club would make \$271.00 per skid.
 - iii. Ken reminded the group that the cost of one trap motor was \$469.00.
 - iv. Shells increased from \$75.00 per flat to \$85.00.
 - v. Next year's cost increased could be set at \$5.00/round (yet to be determined)
